Product: Bulk Antigens for Immunodiagnostic Test

Composition: Antigens for immunological assays (EIA, Western Blot, IHA, Line-assays, etc.) are prepared from infected cell cultures or microorganisms grown in axenic media (bacteria, parasites, etc.). They are partially purified and are supplied lyophilized or frozen. They may contain NaN_3 or Thimerosal. Refer to the Certificate of Analysis Sheet for details.

For cell lines and strains used, please request separate list.

Infectivity: All antigens are treated during preparation by procedures that should effectively kill the infectious agents (high pH, organic solvent treatment, detergent treatment, sonication, Thimerosal, β -propiolactone etc.)

No viable organisms could be recovered by subsequent culture

All reagents (sera for cultures, BSA, etc.) of bovine origin used in the production of these products originate in countries (USA, Argentina, Chile, Australia, etc) where no Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) has been reported.

Toxic Substances Contain <0.1% Thimerosal after reconstitution or <1.0% NaN_3 .

Precautions: Since no procedure can guarantee absolute sterility of the products, when handling the reagent the same precautions should be taken as when working with any similar potentially infectious material.

Gloves should be worn.

Autoclave or treat all materials used with standard disinfectants.
